Further, as announced earlier, the RCSC has made the following changes from 2015-16 intake onwards:

1. Opportunity to study in the top Indian Institutions/Universities;
2. Automatically become the member of Nehru-Wangchuck Scholarship Alumni Association;
3. Increased monthly stipend from Rs. 25,000 to Rs. 50,000 and a one-time establishment allowance of Rs. 10,000 for the first month of Scholarship; and
4. Other entitlements such as air fare, research/thesis expenses, medical coverage, book allowance, tuition fees, etc. remains same.

**Eligibility Criteria**

The applicants should fulfill the following criteria:

1. Minimum of 55% in the Undergraduate Degree;
2. Should be RCSC-Select graduates; and
3. Fulfill all other criteria prescribed in the BCSR 2012.
