Public Notification

As mandated by the Constitution of the Kingdom of Bhutan for ACC to "take necessary steps to prevent & combat corruption in the Kingdom" and the Royal Civil Service Commission (RCSC) as the "central personnel agency of the Government" (Article 27, Section 1 and Article 26, Section 8 respectively) and the recommendation of the 19th Session of the National Council, RCSC and ACC have agreed as follows:

1. ACC shall share all complaints that are administrative in nature with the RCSC, pertaining to the civil service including GSP/ESP who are governed by the Bhutan Civil Service Rules & Regulations (BCSR).
2. RCSC as the final authority for administrative matters vis-à-vis civil servants, such matters will end with whatever actions RCSC deems appropriate based on the Civil Service Act 2010 and Bhutan Civil Service Rules and Regulations (BCSR).
3. However, should the examination/inquiry into the complaint reveal prima facie evidence of corrupt act/s, RCSC shall inform ACC as a priority with its preliminary findings and documents, if any, for ACC to further pursue the case.
4. ACC shall report on the complaints shared with RCSC in the ACC annual reports. Similarly, RCSC shall report on the action/s taken on such administrative complaints originated from ACC in the RCSC annual reports.
