

Notification

To minimize the risk of introduction of COVID-19 into the country, the government restricted import of many non-essential items including meat and dry fish from March 23, 2020.

The Ministry would like to notify the general public that import of processed, frozen and packaged meat (beef, chicken, fish, chevon, mutton and other sea food) including dry fish will be allowed from the companies registered with BAFRA with effect from June 22, 2020

However, import of live pigs, pork and pork products will still be restricted owing to the ongoing outbreak of African Swine Fever in India. The wholesale importers shall import and distribute to the retail shopkeepers. In the interest of keeping everyone in business, importers will not be allowed to hold retail counters and sell directly in the local market. The general public is requested to abide by this notification.
